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Very nice job! As for paint I use matt white spray paint from your local DIY center. For a figure of that detail I would "dust" the figure i.e lightly spray the figure so the first coat looks like it's dusty. then wait for it to dry and repeat the process until you have a nice even finish. Time is your best friend when spraying a figure...don't rush it and you'll be happy with the results.

Ensure any wax residue has been removed for best paint adhesion and shake the bleep out of the can as it's new.
