So if it's an airplane with a nose, wings, fuselage, tail and engines (example) I could upload a picture of the finished model and upload each part, identifying it to the main store page.

When a potential customer looks at it, they will see that it is a multi-part model, each piece that is printed for it, and be able to buy the entire thing in one click.
