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Well, in order to sell a ton of these, I've have to have Shapeways make 2 tons. We have about a 50% reject rate due to Shapeway's orientation of the model - horizontal, reject: sideways, PERFECT. Shapeways says they cannot specify the orientation to the production planner, so it's basically a coin toss for the orientation. See this forum:

If we were just creating a pretty rose, no text, I could probably live with the stepping. The units created sideways have perfect text, even the ones with maximum text thus smaller font.
