Hi folks,

I've uploaded a few models I intent to print in full color sandstone. While some show the pricing I expect (white strong and flexible more expensive than sandstone), others confuse me - for example, http://www.shapeways.com/model/1191827?etId=11030798&utm_source=automated-contact&utm_medium=email&utm_campaign=model-processing-success shows a white strong & flexible pricing of \$174.84, but a sandstone price of \$176.93, even though sandstone is supposed to be cheaper per volume.

Why is that?
