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The error reported is:

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That explains your problem, as you can see it's 100 times larger than you intended. You could try opening the vrmf in notepad, go down to where you see scale, and adjust the scale accordingly. It should say 1.000 plus or minus some 0's for x y and z. I think you would change them to .01 to make the file 1/100th scale. Can't recall if it's inverse in vrmf, so it may be 100.
