Unfortunately this model was just way too flimsy to be printed in Stainless Steel, but comes out rather well in WSF.

The chainwork is just 1mm diameter 'wires' and the numbers 1.5mm thick by about 12mm tall.

To finish this model, I'll be painting it, probably antiqued brass with gold coloured numbers (unless anyone has any better suggestions).

The model is quite stable, I just tested it on a set of scales... pressing on the upmost face, the scales went to 350g before I felt it was the right time to stop... the model 'gave' some, but didn't crumble.

It will balance on a corner, but the biggest downfall is that it will stop on an edge maybe 2 times out of every 40 throws.
