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Very nice design. I like it. At the beginning I thought it was a cup for an egg and was wondering how you would insert the egg inside it, but for the coffee it is perfect.
I would only worry about the sharp edges of the handle: the glaze could wear off at those edges. If you should round them a little bit (see the design rules): it would be safer.

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well i tried to make it rounded but the software doesn't let me make that because they are sizes under 1mm i'm working on that and yes the handle have a slit that goes trough it is aproximately 3mm width i do this to make the cup with less material i don't know if it will print ok that have to be tested i will check that too thanks for the advice
